#### Zion's Mission Statement: Reflecting Christ, we are called to share God's gifts

Lent, Spiritual Disciplines and Stories of Faith

Christians all around the world mark the 40 days leading up to Easter, called Lent, as time to re-focus on our relationship with Jesus Christ. We recall his journey to the cross and ultimately his sufferings and death. We model his obedience to God as we discipline ourselves, often giving up something or taking on a spiritual discipline.

A spiritual discipline is a practice that connects us to God. Examples of spiritual disciplines often lifted up during Lent are fasting, prayer and giving. This Lent we will look at seven spiritual disciplines, including fasting, prayer and giving, but also acts of service, confession, study of scripture and worship. Each week, beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending on Palm Sunday, we will focus on one particular spiritual discipline.

This focus on spiritual disciplines is very typical (and healthy!) during Lent. This year, however, we will look at these slightly differently. Rather than begin by considering them in our own lives, we will first think about them in the lives of others. We will consider people in our lives who have practiced this spiritual discipline over the years. As we reflect on their life, we will be able to see the faith and love that came from this discipline. It will be a season of telling stories of people, living and dead, who have shown us the love and power in these disciplines and ultimately in Christ. Hopefully this leads us to consider how we implement this spiritual discipline more fully into our life.

For each Sunday, I will ask (or you can volunteer!) two to three people (including hopefully a confirmation student) to share for 1-2 minutes during the sermon time about a person. After these stories, my sermon will help tie these stories more deeply into the biblical text. After hearing these examples and the Bible story, we will invite each person in the church to consider someone in their life who has practiced this spiritual discipline. The following Wednesday night we will gather these names and put them together into a tapestry (of sorts). These will create a visual representation of people who have lived out the Christian faith and inspired us. (This will be a powerful witness to the Communion of Saints of which we confess in the Apostle's Creed!) After we have shared some stories with each other, we will conclude our evening with an evening prayer service in the sanctuary.

Council Covenant: The Council discussed mutual expectations of each other, based on Scripture's high level of expectations of spiritual leaders within the Christian community. A signed copy of this covenant will be posted in the room where Council meets beginning in February.

Committee Meetings: Council discussed the functioning of Committee night moving forward. The following suggestions were made:

- Implement room assignments for committee meetings
- Recommend that someone should not be participating in more than 2 committees
- Because it is most crucial for Pastor to attend Worship and Music, there is a suggestion to stagger the time of this particular committee.

Launching Shepherding: Pastor is hoping to begin a shepherding ministry this year.
