May God grant us courage, hope, and strength to participate in new life, wherever and however it is found. Alleluia, alleluia.

## Sunday School Updates!

A special Sunday School date: May 14th Pr. Caitlin will be having a Communion class for all children and their parents/guardians. This class will include all children including those that already commune. \*see below June 4th - Pentecost Sunday will also be Confirmation Sunday - we will honor the Confirmands, Max Ludwig, Ellyse Ludwig, Joseph Beidler and Kaitlyn Boisvert with a luncheon following the worship service. A sign up sheet will be on the bulletin board in the Gathering area.

The last week for classroom Sunday school for children age 3 through 5th grade will be June 4th.

\*Come to the Table Communion Class on Sunday, May 14, beginning at 9:30 AM. Communion is God's gift to God's children, a way God nourishes the baptized in living lives of service, love, and faith. The Church teaches that the only requirement for Holy Communion is baptism; while individual congregations may have age requirements for Holy Communion, those requirements are tradition and practice, not doctrine. At Zion's, baptized children of all ages are welcome to commune as soon as their parents or guardians give permission for them to do so. As a congregation, we promise to continually teach disciples of all ages about what the sacrament is and the promises it conveys to us. As with many things in life, and in faith, what one understands about the sacrament at five will be different than what they understand at fifteen, twenty-five, and ninety-five. Our responsibility is to continually teach so that disciples continually grow in their understanding of God's grace revealed in the sacraments. To this end, we will be offering an all-ages communion class on Sunday, May 14 in the Social Hall. Parents/guardians, please plan to attend with your child. Children who are not yet communing, but wish (with their parents consent) to begin communing will celebrate First Communion on Sunday, May 21. All children who have begun communing in the past year will also be recognized that Sunday. If you have any questions about this class, or about Zion's communion practices, please speak with Pastor Caitlin.

Zion's 2017 Vacation Bible School will be held Sunday, June 25-Thursday June 29.




"40 ACTION TEAMS IN 40 DAYS


