#### Pastor's Pen

God's grace and peace be with you this day! Today I want to say "thank you" for the privilege of serving as your pastor, and "thank you" for all the ways you make the ministries of Zion's possible.

Often, I get to do fun, creative, faithful ministry with you—for example, Vacation Bible School (which is happening this week), Release Time (a ministry wherein we get to teach Jonestown Elementary 3<sup>rd</sup> graders about God's love), Day Camp, Sunday School, Joyful Spirits, Bible study, and the like. Your gifts of time, talent, and financial support help make these ministries possible, and I'm grateful. Together, we are growing as disciples of Christ as we welcome our neighbors, learn about God's Word, and serve the community.

Sometimes, though, I get to do faithful ministry behind the scenes on your behalf; your financial support, prayers and trust also make these ministries possible, and I want to say "thank you" for these opportunities, too. In addition to the pastoral conversations I regularly have with families in crisis, transition, or celebration, I have the privilege of sharing with those in need resources that you collect and entrust to me like the boxes and boxes of Pull-ups you brought in for a family in our community! I have the privilege of offering scholarships for kids to attend Day Camp, of giving Bibles to families who don't have any, of inviting people to come for a free meal on Wednesday nights during the school year, and sharing snacks from our kitchen with people who are hungry and on long journeys. I have the privilege of inviting families with children with special needs to join us for Joyful Spirits, and of assuring these same families that we will do all that we can to meet their child's unique needs so they too can participate in VBS. When someone's recovering from surgery, I get to offer meals. When a loved one has died, I get to say "sure, we'll host a funeral luncheon at Zion's." When someone needs a ride to worship or home from some activity, I get to say with confidence "I'm sure we can figure that out". Many of these stories aren't shared, and some can't be shared, but I want you to know that these moments of generosity, and caring and sharing God's love, happen day in and day out through the ministries of Zion's, and our presence in the community. Thank you for your prayers, your trust, and your financial gifts. Without your support, fewer lives would be touched and transformed by the love of Christ.
