God's grace and peace to you this day! It is GOOD to be back with you after my maternity leave. Seth and I would like to thank you for your support, prayers, cards and gifts following Madelyn's birth, and for your understanding of our need for some time together as a family. A few reflections from my leave:

- 1. It is so good to be part of a *consistent* community of faith. We went to worship as a family every week except the two Sundays immediately following Madelyn's birth. We were grateful to worship at Zion's two of those weeks but used the rest of the time as a rare opportunity to visit other congregations (I am always on the look-out for new ideas!) It was nice to experience other communities, but we really did miss the sense of family we share here at Zion's. It made me mindful of the many people in our community who *don't* have a spiritual place to call 'home', and more intentional about inviting new people to be a part of our community. I hope you'll join me in that endeavor.
- 2. Worshiping with children (even a newborn) can be hard. One Sunday in particular, Madelyn was not feeling very 'worshipful', and nothing we did helped. People were gracious, but I was embarrassed and ultimately ended up in the Social Hall with her wondering why we even tried. I recognize that this is a season of life, and simply offer a "thank you" and "keep up the good work" to all parents (and grandparents) who do what needs to be done to bring your little ones to church, as well as a "thank you" and "keep up the good work" to congregations who welcome these families with open arms and lend a hand when needed. Together, we *can* raise our young people to know, love, and serve God…but it takes a village.
- 3. Life is busy. Seth and I had the really unique opportunity to *both* be home with Madelyn in the first weeks of her life. Our only responsibility during those days was to care for her, care for ourselves, pay the bills, and keep the house relatively presentable. And it was hard. Days and weeks would pass and I would wonder "What the heck did we do today?" For the first time in ten years, I was not eating, sleeping, and breathing 'church'—I was going to worship on Sundays, praying (a lot), and simply trying to make it through the day with a whole new set of responsibilities. This experience gave me a larger appreciation for the challenge families face in prioritizing and balancing their lives and made me wonder how the church might do a better job of supporting individuals and families who want to live faith-filled, Godly lives in our fast-paced, overly busy world. I don't have answers, but do have lots of questions and a few ideas. If this is something you're passionate about too, and you have ideas or thoughts (or questions!) to answer, please let me know!

Seth and I are grateful for the time we had together, and grateful to return to ministry in this community of faith. We look forward to witnessing Madelyn grow in faith and life surrounded by the love of this congregation and invite you to be a part of her baptism during worship on Sunday, August 12, and then to join us for lunch afterwards! To round out a summer of exciting news, we recently bought a house in the Twin Creeks neighborhood, and moved in this week! We look forward to being part of the Jonestown community in the years to come.

I hope to see you in worship during these last 'dog days' of summer as we are nourished by God's Word, loved in community, and are strengthened by the Lord's Supper to serve God in our daily lives.
